Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has filed F.C.O.P.No.79 of 2022 seeking Restitution of Conjugal Rights (RCR) before the Family Court at Kukatpally and as per the visitation orders issued by the said Court, he has appeared to see his daughter on 13.06.2026. Respondent No.5 is the brother of petitioner's wife. Respondent No.5 came along with the petitioner's wife, created nuisance and abused the	Transferred to i-order before corrections

		petitioner in filthy language and also threatened with dire consequences and the same was captured in CCTV Footage at Ground Floor of Kukatpally Court Complex on 13.06.2026 at 12.30 to 1.30 P.M. He further submits that duration of the availability of the CCTV Footage is only one month. After one month, the video recording will be automatically deleted and proceed to day by day capture mode. He further submits that the CCTV Footage is crucial and vital evidence to support the allegations of the petitioner against respondent No.5 and is also a conclusive evidence to disprove the allegation against the petitioner. He further submits that since case and counter case have been registered <i>vide</i> F.I.R.Nos.811 and 826 of 2026 on 27.06.2026 and 01.07.2026 against respondent No.5 and the petitioner, collection of CCTV Footage is crucial. On the other hand, learned Assistant Government Pleader opposed for the same. In view of the above submissions, since the CCTV Footage on the day of 13.06.2026 at 12.30 to 1.30 P.M. at ground floor premises of Kukatpally Court	
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		Complex, appears to be crucial and vital evidence for further investigation, this Court deems it appropriate to direct respondent No.4 to take steps to collect the same for further investigation in F.I.R.Nos.811 and 826 of 2026 dated 13.06.2026 and 01.07.2026 respectively and respondent No.6 shall save the said CCTV Footage.
