The appellants are the Telangana State Wakf Board aggrieved by the common impugned judgment dated 17.04.2026 passed in the batch of writ petitions, whereunder the Gazette Notification No.7-A, dated 16.02.1989 declaring the subject land as wakf property under challenge was set aside by the learned writ Court. The rejection of the application for occupancy rights certificate vide memo, dated 04.12.2019 assailed by the writ petitioners had been directed to be reconsidered without relying on the said Gazette Notification, which stood quashed. 		Learned Standing Counsel for the appellants has prayed for stay of the impugned judgment. Learned Standing Counsel submits that there are good grounds on merits for the appellants to succeed. Therefore, the impugned judgment may be stayed as it is likely that the writ petitioners may alienate the property in the meantime. Learned Senior Counsel for the writ petitioners prays for two weeks' time to file reply to the prayer for stay. Two weeks' time, as prayed for, is allowed. List these matters on 13.08.2026.
