This Court delivered the following:-

ORDER

Even today, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

2. Heard learned Asst. Govt. Pleader for revenue, appearing for respondent No.1 and learned Asst. Govt. Pleader for Agriculture, appearing for respondent Nos.2 and 3.

3. This Contempt Case is filed alleging willful and deliberate disobedience of the order dated 18.04.2023 passed by this Court in W.P.No.10452 of 2023 by the respondent herein.



4. Vide the aforesaid order, this Court directed the respondent No1 herein to consider the representation dated 13.03.2023 submitted by the petitioner and pass appropriate orders strictly in accordance with law.

5. The respondent No.3 has filed counter wherein paragraph No.7 of the counter, respondent has specifically contended that the petitioner is holding an extent of Ac.13.08 guntas, they have not extended the benefits during 2019 (Vankalam) and 2019 (Yasangi) along with all the other farmers in the State. However, the District Collector in the speaking order dated 19.10.2023 found that Rythu Bandhu amount for 2019 (Vanakalam), 2019 (Yasangi) was not released to the petitioner even though the data was sent to the Government and a report was submitted to the Commissioner and Director of Agriculture Department, Hyderabad for further release of the payment of said Rythu Bandhu amount to the petitioner.

6. Therefore, the respondents have complied with the order under contempt.

7. Though the counter was filed on 05.03.2026, the petitioner did not file any reply or rejoinder adverting the same.



8. To punish the contemnor in terms of Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, there should be willful and deliberate violation of the order.

9. In the light of the same, this Court is of the view that there is no violation, much less willful and deliberate violation of the order 18.04.2023 passed by this Court in WP No.10452 of 2023 by the respondent herein.

10. Therefore, this Contempt Case is closed.

As a sequel, the miscellaneous applications, if any, pending in the Contempt Case shall stand closed.

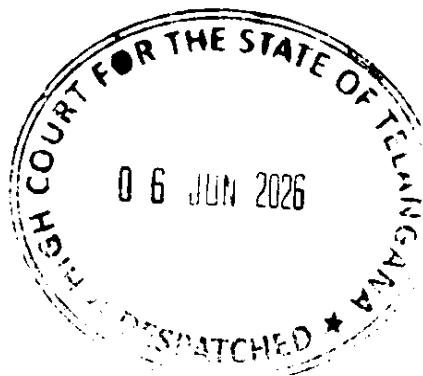
