Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ order or direction, more particularly in the nature of a Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondent No.5 in sealing the petitioner's premises bearing H.No.2-1- 180/2, 1st Floor, Nallakunta, Hyderabad - 500044 on 04.07.2026, without issuing any notice or intimation to the Petitioner herein or serving a copy of the panchanama as arbitrary, illegal, unconstitutional, violative of Article 14, 15, 21 and 300A of the Constitution of India, and is bad in law and consequently direct the Respondent No.5 herein to restore the possession of the said premises to the Petitioner herein under due acknowledgement and consequentially declare the proceedings of the Respondent No.3 herein appointing the Respondent Nos.6 to 10 herein as the non hereditary Trustees of the Sri Shivaiah Durga Bhavani Temple, 2-1-179, 2-1-180 and 2-1-180/1, Nallakunta, Hyderabad - 500 044, as bad in law and quash the same as illegal and consequently direct the Respondent No.2 herein to immediately and forthwith administer the affairs of the said temple.
