WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through their Advocate SRI A. SANTHOSH KUMAR presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of Respondents , particularly the Respondent No.3 in not allotting House Numbers and PTIN to the Petitioners newly constructed residential building situated in Survey Nos.117 and 118, Plot Nos.30 and 31, admeasuring a total extent of 358 square yards, located at Injapur Village, erstwhile Turkayamjal Municipality, Ranga Reddy District, and in not considering the Petitioners Self-Assessment Applications bearing Nos.7150007763 and 7150007765 dated 24.06.2026, as illegal, arbitrary, unreasonable, violative of the principles of natural justice and consequently violative of Articles 14, 19, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India, and consequently direct the Respondents , particularly the Respondent No.3 to consider the Petitioners Self-Assessment Applications bearing Nos.7150007763 and 7150007765, both dated 24.06.2026, and consequently allot PTIN and House Numbers to the Petitioners newly constructed residential building situated in Survey

Nos.117 and 118, Plot Nos.30 and 31, admeasuring a total extent of 358 square yards, located at Injapur Village, during the pendency of the present Writ Petition.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of SRI A. SANTHOSH KUMAR Advocate for the Petitioners, GP FOR MUNICIPAL ADMINISTRATION AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT for the Respondent No.1, SMT. M. BHAGYASREE, Standing Counsel for the Respondents No. 3 and 4 directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 25.08.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

Registry is directed not to take out notice to respondents 1, 3 & 4 in view of the above waiver.

The learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 and to file proof of service in the registry.

Pending the writ petition, the respondent Nos.3 and 4 are directed to consider the petitioners' self-assessment applications bearing Nos.7150007763 and 7150007765 dated 24.6.2026 and take appropriate decision thereon, strictly in accordance with law, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
