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referred for mediation.

This Court opines and even believes that through an effort of mediation there would not only be faster dispute resolution of the issues involved between the petitioner Rice Mills and the Respondent State Government, but also reasonable opportunity would be ensured to both the parties leading to creative solutions which aim to satisfy both parties and eventually arrive at fair and sustainable settlements. This would further not only preserve the relationships between the petitioner/Rice Millers and respondent/ State Government which is the primary concern of the petitioners herein, but also reduce litigation costs to both the petitioners and the State government as well.

This Court is of the firm opinion that sincere efforts should be put-forth for resolving the subject issue involved in the batch of writ petitions, duly taking into consideration the specific concerns of both the petitioner rice mills and also the State Government through mediation to ensure that interests of both the parties would eventually be protected on arriving at an amicable settlement.
