Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or Direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of 2nd respondent in raising demand to an amount of Rs.95,75,781/- alleged to be dues in respect of the Power Supply Connection bearing No.SGR 422, by issuing in Lr. No.SE/OP/SGR/SAO/AAO/JAO/HT/ D.No. 244/ 2023, dated 19-06-2023 thereby sought to be recovered from the petitioners service connection bearing SC.No.SGR.1831 situated at Plot No.19/A, Sy.No. 181/1 to 15, Khazipally Village, Jinnaram, Sangareddy at as wholly illegal, untenable, unjust and contrary to the Provisions of Electricity Act,2003 as well the Regulations of Supply Code, General Terms of Conditions of supply and the T.S.Revenue Recovery Act,1864 as such if any such dues alleged to be arrears are hopelessly barred by provisions of Limitation Act,1963 and consequently direct the respondents refraining from disconnection of supply to the service connection to the petitioner aforementioned service connection.
