Metropolitan Sessions Judge, Secunderabad, pending disposal of CRLP No. 10179 of 2024, on the file of the High Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is also permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 by registered post with acknowledgment due and file proof of service in the Registry by the next date of hearing.

List the matter on 03.10.2024.

If there are no warrants pending against the petitioner, the appearance of petitioner/accused before the trial Court is dispensed with whenever her presence is not required subject to the condition that petitioner/accused is being represented by her counsel on every date of hearing and in case of non-appearance of the petitioner/accused on the specific date so fixed by the trial Court for her appearance, this order gets vacated automatically.
