Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to pass an order, direction, or writ, particularly one in the nature of a Writ of Mandamus, declaring the high handed, arbitrary, and lawless action of the Respondent No. 3 Police in attempting to dispossess the Petitioner from the subject Property admeasuring 250 sq. yards in Survey No. 34, Teegalaguda, Malakpet, Hyderabad, under the threats of registering false cases and at the instance of Respondents No. 4, as being completely illegal, unauthorized, and violative of Articles 14, 21, and 300A of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the Respondent No. 3 Police not to interfere in any manner with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the Petitioner over the Subject Property.

I.A. NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to Interim Direction thereby directing the Respondent No. 3 Police, not to interfere with the peaceful physical possession of the Petition attempting to dispossess him from the Subject Property, admeasurinig 250 sq. yards in Survey No. 34, Teegalaguda Village, Malakpet, Hyderabad, any illegal manner whatsoever, pending disposal of WP No 22513 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI MOHAMMAD ADNAN Advocate for the Petitioner and AGP FOR HOME for the Respondents No. 1 to 3 and SRI MIR MUKARRAM ALI, Counsel for the Respondent No.4, the Court made the following.

ORDER:

Based on the written instructions submitted by the learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home, the respondent police are directed not to interfere with the petitioner's peaceful possession and enjoyment of the subject property.

Mr. M.I.R. Mukarram Ali, learned counsel for respondent No.4, seeks time to file vakalat and counter-affidavit.
