01.	16.07.2026	<u>JSR, J</u> <u>I.A.No.1 of 2026</u> Dispensed with for the present. <u>JSR,J</u> <u>Crl.P.No.11148 of 2026</u> This Criminal Petition is filed by the petitioner seeking to quash the proceedings in FIR No.50 of 2026 of Wyra Police Station, Khammam, for the offences punishable under Section 69 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhitha, 2023. Heard Ms.K.Siri Vennela, learned counsel for the petitioner and Ms.M.Haritha, learned counsel for respondent No.1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not committed any offence and has been falsely implicated in the present crime. The petitioner and respondent No.1 have known each other for a long time, and their relationship was consensual. Subsequently, at the instance of their elders and well-wishers, they resolved their disputes and solemnized their marriage on 23.05.2026. Their marriage was duly registered before the competent authority, and a	Transferred to i.o. folder before corrections, if any.

Marriage Certificate was issued on 25.06.2026. Since then, the petitioner and respondent No.1 have been living together as husband and wife. Both parties have filed I.A.Nos.3 and 4 of 2026 seeking permission to compound the offence and to record the compromise. Along with the said applications, they have also filed a joint memo.

Learned counsel for respondent No.1 also submits that the petitioner and respondent No.1 are living together as husband and wife and their marriage was solemnized in accordance with their customs and subsequently registered before the competent authority.

Taking into consideration the above submissions, the Marriage Certificate, the sworn affidavit of respondent No.1, and the joint memo filed by the parties, the petitioner and respondent No. 1 are directed to appear before the High Court Legal Services Committee on or before 25.07.2026. On such appearance, the High Court Legal Services Committee is directed to submit a report before this Court on or before the next date of hearing.

Hence, the Registry is directed to transmit the case file to the High Court Legal Services Committee immediately.
