WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI P.RAMA SHARANA SHARMA, presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to pass an order or direction or writ in the nature of Mandamus duly declaring the inaction of the 4th respondent herein in considering petitioner representation/ reply date 20.04.2026 on the show cause notice on disconnection of power connection to the petitioner's house vide Lr.No.ADE/Op/KGM Town/D.No.173/25-26 dated 20.06.2025 citing the order of this Hon'ble High Court in WP No. 15535 of 2024 dated 07.01.2025 in respect of

property vide H.No.4-4-148/7/1 at Survey number 169 at Viswanadha Colony Kothagudem town and District as illegal arbitrary and against the principles of natural justice and consequently direct the 4th respondent to restore the power connection to the above property forthwith.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of SRI P.RAMA SHARANA SHARMA, Advocate for the Petitioner, GP FOR ENERGY, for the respondent No.1 and SRI A.CHANDRA SEKHAR, SC FOR NPDCL, for the respondent No.2 to 4, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.5, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
