Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus:

(A) By declaring the action of the respondents, particularly action of the 2nd Respondent in issuing the present impugned order Rc.No.A1/2191/2026-8 dated 09.07.2026, wherein deputing the services of the petitioner from the post of ATDO, Kothaguda, Mahabubabad District to that of DTDO (FAC), Hanumakonda on deputation basis to work far away of 75 kms, is as highly illegal, arbitrary, contrary to provisions of FR 110 (a) and set aside or quash the same.

(B) Further hold that the entire procedure adopted by the 2nd respondent for issuing the present impugned order vide proceedings Rc.No.A1 /2191/2026-8 dated 09.07.2026 wherein deputing the services of the petitioner to far away place, without there being his consent is contrary to the FR 110 (a).

(C) Consequently, to direct the respondent to retain and continue the petitioner in the present place of working as ATDO at Kothaguda, Mahabubabad

District by suspending the operation of the present impugned proceedings Rc. No.A1/2191/2026-8 dated 09.07.2026.

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents to retain and continue the petitioner in the present place of working as ATDO at Kothaguda, Mahabubabad District by suspending the operation of the present impugned proceedings Rc.
