ORDER

1. This Memorandum of Criminal Petition is filed under Sections 480 and 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (BNSS) praying this Court to enlarge the petitioner-Accused No.1 on bail in connection with FIR No.520 of 2026 of Dundigal Police Station, Cyberabad Commissionerate, Medchal Malkajgiri District. The offences alleged against the petitioner are punishable under Sections 64(2)(m) and 89 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (BNS) and Section 5(l) read with 6 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 (POCSO Act) and Section

79 of the Juvenile Justice (Care And Protection Of Children) Act, 2015.

2. Heard Sri R. Tirupathi, learned counsel for petitioner and Sri D. Arun Kumar, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, appearing for respondent – State.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner-accused No.1 is produced before the concerned Court, whereby he was remanded to judicial custody on 25.05.2026. Petitioner is innocent and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. Petitioner-accused No.1 has filed bail application *vide* Crl.M.P.No.900 of 2026 before the I Additional District and Sessions Judge, Medchal-Malkajgiri District at Kushaiguda under Section 483 of BNSS, which came to be dismissed *vide* order dated 13.07.2026. Entire investigation is completed, petitioner is no longer required for the purpose of investigation and prayed to enlarge him on bail.

4. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor has drawn attention of this Court to the complaint dated 24.05.2026 and also Remand Case Dairy dated 25.05.2026. He further submits that the statement of the victim girl under Section 164 of Cr.P.C. (Section 183 of BNSS) is recorded on 03.06.2026.

5. Remand case dairy dated 25.05.2026 goes to show that petitioner-accused No.1 was arrested and produced before the concerned Court, thereby he was remanded to judicial custody on 25.05.2026. Remand case dairy further shows that prosecution has already examined fifteen (15) witnesses in support of the prosecution and the statement of the victim under Section 183 of BNSS is also recorded. As investigation is at fag end, detaining the petitioner-accused No.1 further will not serve the purpose for the prosecution. Petitioner-accused No.1 has made out a case for grant of bail and he is entitled for the same, subject to the following conditions:

- i. Since, the petitioner-accused No.1 is a resident of Rajasthan, he shall execute a personal bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only), with two local sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the learned VIII Additional Metropolitan Magistrate, Cyberabad at Medchal.
- ii. The petitioner-accused No.1 shall appear before the concerned SHO between 10:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., on every Sunday for a period of eight (8) weeks or till filing of charge sheet whichever is earlier, for the

purpose of investigation and thereafter, as and when required.

- iii. The petitioner-accused No.1 shall abide by the conditions stipulated in Section 437(3) of Cr.P.C. (presently, Section 480(3) of the BNSS).
- iv. The petitioner-accused No.1 shall not directly or indirectly influence, threaten or induce any of the prosecution witnesses.
- v. In the event of violation of any of the above conditions, the prosecution is at liberty to file an application for cancellation of bail.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Petition is allowed.

Miscellaneous applications, if any pending, shall stand closed.
