Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to Issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of Respondent Nos.2 and 3 in acting in collusion with Respondent Nos.4 to 9 and attempting to dispossess the petitioner from the residential house bearing Municipal No.22-3- 577, Zehra Nagar Colony, Mir Alam Mandi, Hyderabad, without following due process of law, as illegal, arbitrary,

unconstitutional and violative of Articles 14, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India, consequently to direct Respondent Nos.2 and 3 not to interfere either directly or indirectly, nor permit Respondent No. 4 - 9 or any third parties, including antisocial elements, to interfere with or attempt to dispossess the petitioners from the subject property, except in accordance with due process of law, forthwith pending disposal of the present writ petition and pass such any other order or orders as this court may deem fit and proper under the circumstances of the case and in the interest of justice and direct Respondent Nos.2 and 3 to provide adequate police protection to the petitioner and her family members against the illegal acts, threats and interference of Respondent Nos.4 to 9 and their associates

ORDER:

Alleging interference by respondent No.3 at the behest of respondent Nos.4 to 9 in trying to dispossess the petitioner from residential house bearing No.22-3-577, Zehra Nagar Colony, Mir Alam Mandi, Hyderabad, without following due process of law, as illegal and arbitrary, this writ petition has been filed.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home appearing for the respondent Nos.1 to 3.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondent No.3, at the behest of respondent Nos.4 to 9 is trying to dispossess

the petitioner solely on the ground that the property is adjacent to Masjid and the unofficial respondents claim the property of the petitioner to be belonging to Masjid. He further submitted that the petitioner's nephew has lodged a complaint which has been registered as Cr.No.178 of 2026 dated 09.07.2026 but so far no action has been taken by the respondents to protect the petitioner's property.

4. Learned Assistant Government Pleader, on written instructions, submits that the complaint of one Mr.Mohd. Masroor Ali has been considered and Cr.No.178 of 2026 is registered and similarly another complaint by respondent No.6 herein i.e., Mohd. Baquer Hussain has been received and it has been registered as Cr.No.183 of 2026 dated 14.07.2026 under Sections 115(2), 351(2) of the BNS and investigation is under progress. It is submitted that there is no attempt by respondent No.6 to dispossess the petitioner from the residential house and the allegation of interference in civil disputes is denied.

5. In view of the above submissions, this Court directs respondent No.3 not to interfere in civil disputes, and advise the

parties to approach the competent civil court concerned for adjudication of the disputes. However, respondent No.3 shall proceed with the investigation into the crimes registered and the petitioner shall cooperate with the police in respect of the same.

6. The writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.

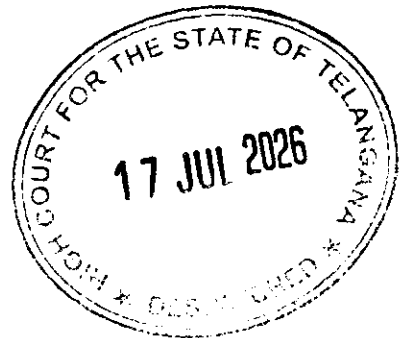
