Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order, or direction, more particularly in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondents in not permitting the petitioners to participate in the survey proceedings conducted on 22/08/2025 without adding their names in the notice dated 18/08/2025 as arbitrary, illegal, unjust and violative of principles of natural justice consequently direct the respondents to include the petitioners names in the notice and conduct the survey proceedings afresh after giving due notice and opportunity of participation to the petitioners.

IA NO: 1 OF 2025

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents by permitting the petitioners to participate in the survey proceedings conducted on 22/08/2025, pending disposal of the main Writ Petition, Pending disposal of WP 24982 of 2025, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri VENTRAPRAGADA ARAVIND, Advocate for the Petitioners, GP FOR REVENUE for the Respondent Nos.1 to 4 and the Court made the following.

ORDER:

Sri Nandyala Venkateshwara Reddy and his wife filed writ petition vide W.P.No.1319 of 2024 against the petitioners herein and respondents to declare the memo dated 30.09.2019 issued by Assistant Director/ Inspector of Survey, Survey and Land Records, Medchal Malkajgiri, as illegal.

Vide order dated 04.09.2024, this Court dismissed the said writ petition holding that during pendency of the suits which are specifically mentioned in paragraph No.9 of the order, they cannot seek for survey from 6th respondent therein.

Feeling aggrieved by the said order, they preferred an intra Court appeal under Clause 15 of the Letters Patent vide W.A.No.225 of 2025. Vide order dated 24.03.2025, a Division Bench of this Court disposed of the said writ appeal and remanded the matter back to this Court to re-hear the said writ petition. The said writ petition is pending. During pendency of the said writ petition, on the request made by the 4th respondent, Deputy Inspector of Survey, Survey and Land Records of office of 3rd respondent issued impugned notice dated 18.08.2025 fixing survey on 22.08.2025.

In the light of the same, matter requires examination.

Therefore, there shall be stay of all further proceedings pursuant to the impugned notice dated 18.08.2025 of Deputy Inspector of Survey, Survey and Land Records of office of 3rd respondent.

List along with W.P.No.1319 of 2025 on 11.09.2025.

In the meanwhile, learned counsel for the petitioner shall take steps to implead the Deputy Inspector of Survey, Survey and Land Records, of office of 3rd respondent.
