Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, Order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondent Nos. 4 and 5 in withholding above said life insurance benefits Policy Name. Tata AIA Life Insurance Sampoorana Raksha (UIN. 110N129V03), Policy Number. C077476188, Policy Plan Option: "Sum Assured on death" payable on death which are ought to be released immediately on the event of death of the policy holder to the whole and sole nominee despite the application letter dated 20/08/2025 as illegal, arbitrary and unconstitutional and consequently direct the respondent Nos.2 and 3 to direct the respondent No.5 to

release the with holded life insurance benefits to the petitioner within a period of one week;

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondents Nos. 4 and 5 to pay the compensation as per Section 104 of the Insurance Act 1938 Penalty for contravention of sections 27, 27A, 27B, 27D and 27E. - since the Respondent No.4 and 5 have failed to comply with the provisions of section 27, 27A he shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding twenty-five crore rupees, pending disposal of WP.No.26238 of 2025, on the file of the High Court.
