No.1 of 2026</u> Having satisfied with the reasons mentioned in the affidavit, and also considering the fact that Sri Nazeer Khan, learned counsel representing Sri L.Ram Singh, learned counsel for the respondent, did not oppose this application seriously, this application is allowed and the delay of 211 days in filing the appeal, is condoned. <u>I.A.No.2 of 2026</u> There shall be stay of all further proceedings pursuant to order and decree dated 21.12.2023 in LAOP No.356 of 2022 passed by the learned Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Authority for the State of Telangana at Hyderabad, on the condition of the petitioner depositing 50% of the decretal amount, within a period of six (6) weeks from today. On such deposit, the respondent is permitted to withdraw the same, without furnishing any security.
