Village, Ghatkesar Mandal, Medchal-Malkajgiri District, as being illegal, arbitrary, unreasonable, violative of Articles 14, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and issue a consequential direction directing the respondents not to lay any road in the petitioners land.

Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, aggrieved by the inaction on the part of the 4th respondents in implementing the orders of the 3rd respondents vide Lr.No.2764/GTKR/ Plg/ HMDA/2024 dated 28-08-2024 in demarcating the subject land and in not submitting the revenue sketch map in Sy No. 796 Adm an extent of Ac 1.00 Gts and Ac 1.20 Gts being illegal, irregular and violative of Articles 14 and 21 of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the 4th respondent to implement the directions of the 3rd respondent vide Lr.No.2764/GTKR/Plg/HMDA/2024 dated 28-08-2024 by demarcating the petitioner's landed property with proper boundaries as per the survey report by further duly submitting the revenue sketch map.

COMMON ORDER :

W.P.No.24255 of 2023 is filed seeking to declare the action of respondents in giving markings on the petitioner's land in Survey No.796, with its sub-divisions, admeasuring Ac.1.00 gts and Ac.1.20 gts, (vide Mutation Proceedings of the respondent No.3 in Procs.No.B/1782/2016 and B/1783/2016, dated 28.01.2017) situated at Venkatapuram, hamlet of Korremula Village, Ghatkesar Mandal, Medchal-Malkajgiri District, which was purchased by the petitioners through registered document Nos.1818/2015 and 1817/2015 respectively, as illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional and violative of Articles 14, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India.

2. W.P.No.27634 of 2024 is filed to declare the action of respondent No.4 in implementing the orders of respondent No.3 vide Lr.No.2764/GTKR/Plg/HMDA/2024 dated 28.08.2024 in demarcating the subject land and in not submitting the revenue sketch map in Sy.No.796 admeasuring to an extent of Ac.1.00 gts., and Ac.1.20 gts., as illegal, irregular and violative of Articles 14 and 21 of the Constitution of India.

3. Since the subject property and the petitioners in both the writ petitions is one and the same, they being heard together and disposed of by this common order.

4. It is stated that petitioner No.1 is the owner and possessor of the land admeasuring to an extent of Ac.01.00 gts. in Sy.No.796 situated at Venkatapuram, hamlet of Korremula Village, Ghatkesar Mandal, having purchased the subject property under registered Sale Deed *vide* document No.1818/2015 and petitioner No.2 is the owner and possessor of the land to an extent of Ac.01.20 gts. in Sy.No.796 situated at Venkatapuram, hamlet of Korremula Village, Ghatkesar Mandal, having purchased the subject property under registered Sale Deed *vide* document No 1817/2015 and out of the said extent Ac.0.20 guntas was alienated in favour of respondent No.4 *vide* document No.1476/2017. It is further stated that when the adjacent pattedars have disputed the title and possession of the petitioners claiming that part of the lands are forming part of Sy.Nos.796 and 813, the petitioners have submitted F-line application seeking to conduct survey and demarcation of the said lands. It is further stated that questioning the laying of road from the lands through the petitioners' land, W.P.No.24255 of 2023 was filed. The grievance of the petitioners is that even after issuing the



proceedings Lr.No.2764/GTKR/Plg/HMDA/2024 dated 28.08.2024 the respondent authorities are not fixing the boundaries to the said lands as claimed by them.

5. Considered the submissions made by the learned counsel for the parties and with their consent this writ petition is disposed of at the admission stage.

6. It is settled law that mere conducting of survey does not take away the right of either of the parties, even after third parties are found in possession of the properties, the petitioners have to take appropriate steps for eviction of those persons, who are in occupation of the land. Conducting of mere survey does not create any right nor does it take away any vested right in favour of the petitioners.

7. A perusal of the record would show that acting on the F-Line application submitted by the petitioners, the respondent authorities have conducted the survey and demarcation of the land forming part of Sy.No.796 to an extent of Ac.01.00 gts., and Ac.01.20 gts., situated at Venkatapuram, hamlet of Korremula village, Ghatkesar Mandal and also localized the said lands.

8. This Court, without expressing any opinion on the merits of matters and since the petitioners are the owners and possessors of the lands in Sy.No.796 to an extent of Ac.01.00 gts each and the road alleged to have been laid from the said lands, and it is stated that the respondent authorities are not fixing the boundaries in terms of the survey report, dated 28.08.2024, deems it appropriate to dispose of this writ petition directing the respondents to implement the survey report, dated 28.08.2024 by fixing and localizing the subject land with the boundaries.

9. With the above observations, both the writ petitions are disposed of.

Miscellaneous petitions, if any pending in this writ petition shall stand closed. No costs.

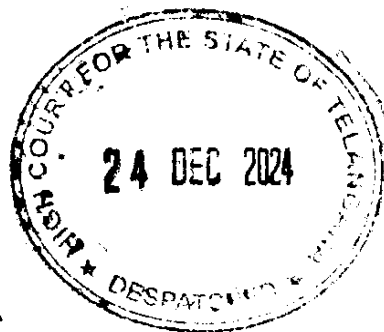
