Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of respondent - State. The petitioner herein/appellant is sole accused in S.C.No.298 of 2017. <i>Vide</i> impugned judgment, dated 26.11.2019, learned Court of the Special Sessions Judge for Fast Tracking the cases relating to atrocities against women, Karimnagar, convicted the petitioner herein for the offences under Sections – 376 (2) (n) and 506 IPC, and sentenced him to undergo life imprisonment. It is the specific contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is in jail from 26.11.2019. On perusal of the record would reveal that PW1-victim and accused are close relatives. It is specifically stated that accused exploited her since last 6 years and committed rape on her 6 times. There is a delay in lodging	

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		the complaint. As discussed supra, the petitioner is in jail from 26.11.2019, this appeal is of the year 2019. Several grounds and contentions raised by the petitioner - appellant can be considered at the time of hearing the appeal itself. We are hearing the appeals of the year 2017 to 2018 and this appeal of the year 2019. There is no possibility of hearing this appeal in the near future. This case is squarely falls within the guidelines enunciated by a Division Bench of High Court of Judicature at Hyderabad for the States of Telangana and Andhra Pradesh, in Batchu Ranga Rao v. State of A.P. [2016 (3) ALT (Cri.) 505 (DB) (AP)]. Therefore, we are inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Therefore, the present petition is allowed. The sentence of imprisonment imposed on the petitioner - appellant alone is suspended pending disposal of the appeal, and the petitioner - appellant, is released on bail on the following conditions: i) He shall execute a personal bond for a	

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		sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two (02) sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of learned Court of the Special Sessions Judge for Fast Tracking the cases relating to atrocities against women, Karimnagar, and ii) He shall not indulge in any criminal acts during bail period. <u>Crl.A.
