Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ more particularly in the nature of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondents more particularly respondents No.3 to 5 in seeking to take over subject land that is land in SY. No. 223, admeasuring AC 11-00 GTS, situated at Velganoor Village, Nizamsagar Mandal, Kamareddy District claiming it to be belonging it without any prior notice or without following due process of law is challenged in this writ petition as being arbitrary, illegal and violative of Articles-14, 19(1)(g), 21 and 300-A of Constitution consequently direct the respondents to desist or refrain from taking over land in SY. No. 223, admeasuring AC 11-00 GTS, situated at Velganoor Village, Nizamsagar Mandal, Kamareddy District without following due process of law.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents no. 2 to 5 not to interfere with the possession of petitioner over land in SY. No. 223, admeasuring AC 11-00 GTS, situated at Velganoor Village, Nizamsagar Mandal, Kamareddy District, pending disposal of WP.No.27436 of 2025, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and the order of the High Court dated 15.09.2025, 23.10.2025, 13.11.2025, 04.12.2025, 08.01.2026 and 16.03.2026 made herein and upon hearing the arguments of SRI. VIJAY B. PAROPAKARI Advocate for the Petitioner, GP FOR FORESTS for the Respondent Nos.1, 3 to 5 and GP FOR REVENUE for the Respondent No.2, the Court made the following.

ORDER:

Heard Sri Vijay B. Paropkari, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner.

Though notice before admission had been ordered on 15.09.2025 no counter affidavit has been filed on behalf of the respondents as on date. The learned Assistant Government Pleader for Forests, appearing on behalf of respondents seeks further time for filing counter affidavit.

The interim order granted by this Court on 15.09.2025 stands extended till 19.06.2026.
