Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ more particularly in the nature of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondents more particularly respondents No.3 to 5 in seeking to take over subject land that is land in SY. No. 223, admeasuring AC 11-00 GTS, situated at Velganoor Village, Nizamsagar Mandal, Kamareddy District claiming it to be belonging it without any prior notice or without following due process of law is challenged in this writ petition as being arbitrary, illegal and violative of Articles-14, 19(1)(g), 21 and 300-A of Constitution consequently direct the respondents to desist or refrain from taking over land in SY. No. 223, admeasuring AC 11-00 GTS, situated at Velganoor Village, Nizamsagar Mandal, Kamareddy District without following due process of law.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents no. 2 to 5 not to interfere with the possession of petitioner

over land in SY. No. 223, admeasuring AC 11-00 GTS, situated at Velganoor Village, Nizamsagar Mandal, Kamareddy District, Pending disposal of WP 27436 of 2025, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI. VIJAY B PAROPAKARI Advocate for the Petitioner, learned Government Pleader for Forest on behalf of the respondents No.1, 3 to 5 & learned Government Pleader for Revenue on behalf of the respondent No. 2, and the Court made the following.

ORDER:

Notice before admission.

Learned Government Pleader for Forest takes notice on behalf of the respondents No.1, 3 to 5 and waives further notice.

Learned Government Pleader for Revenue takes notice on behalf of the respondent No.2 and waives further notice

Registry is directed not to take out notices to respondents No.1 to 5 in view of this waiver.

List this matter on 23.10.2025.

Till such time, all the parties are directed to maintain *status-quo* as on today in respect of the subject property. Further, the petitioner is directed not to enter into the Reserve Forest Area under the guise of status-quo order.
