WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through her Advocate SRI VSRMV PRASAD SANAKA presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Mandamus, declaring the action of the respondents illegally interfering into the petitioner agricultural lands to an extent of Ac.2.00 gts in Sy No.114/3 situated at Miryalaguda village and mandal, Nalgonda dist which was assigned to the petitioner in the year 1997, and and without following due process of law and without giving any reasons, highhandedly trying to dispossess the petitioner from the agricultural lands an extent of Ac.2.00 gts in Sy No.114/3 situated at Miryalaguda village and Mandal, Nalgonda District is highly illegal, arbitrary and against the principles of natural justice and also violative of Articles 14, 19, 21 and 300-A of Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents not to interfere and not to dispossess the petitioner from the agricultural lands an extent of Ac.2.00 gts in Sy No.114/3 situated at Miryalaguda village and Mandal, Nalgonda District without following due process of law in the interest of justice

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri VSRMV PRASAD SANAKA Advocate for the Petitioner and Asst Government Pleader for Revenue take notice for Respondent Nos 1 to 4, GP for Roads and Buildings takes notice for Respondent No.5 and GP for Irrigation takes notice to Respondent No.6 directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
