- (iii) Directing the Respondents to not to interfere with or approach the petitioners and their property in Sy.Nos.723 Part, 724 and 725, Sadasivpet Village, Sadasivpet Mandal totally admeasuring Ac.34.04 gts for recovery of any electricity dues/arrears payable by any third parties
- (iv) Directing the Respondents to grant a fresh electricity connection to the petitioners in Sy.Nos.723 Part, 724 and 725, Sadasivpet Village, Sadasivpet Mandal totally admeasuring Ac.34.04 gts without insisting on payment of any past dues/arrears (if any) payable by third parties.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further action/proceedings against the Petitioner with respect to the past dues/arrears allegedly payable to the Respondent by M/s. ORDER:

This writ petition is filed with the following prayer:

"to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus:

(i) Declaring the action of the Respondents in demanding payment of electricity dues and arrears of M/s Priyadarshini Spinning Mills Ltd (under liquidation) by the Petitioner including by affixing notice of seizure dated-Nil- (affixed on Petitioners premises on 17.12.2021) affixing banner/placard dated-nil- (affixed on 29.11.2021 on Petitioner's property) as illegal, arbitrary and unconstitutional and set aside the same;

(ii) Declaring the action of the respondents in not considering the request of the petitioner for grant of fresh electricity connection by insisting the payment of dues and arrears of unrelated third parties as being illegal, arbitrary and unconstitutional and set aside the same;

(iii) Directing the Respondents to not to interfere with or approach the petitioners and their property in Sy. Nos. 723 Part 724 and 725, Sadasivpet Village, Sadasivpet Mandal totally admeasuring Ac.34.04 gts for recovery of any electricity dues/arrears payable by any third parties;

(iv) Directing the Respondents to grant a fresh electricity connection to the petitioners in Sy.Nos.723 Part 724 and 725, Sadasivpet Village, Sadasivpet Mandal totally admeasuring Ac.

34.04 gts without insisting on payment of any past dues/arrears
(if any) payable by third parties..."

2. Heard Mr. Pasham Mohith, learned counsel for the petitioner, learned Government Pleader for Power Supply and Energy for respondent No.1 and Mr. N. Sreedhar Reddy, learned Standing Counsel for respondent Nos.2 to 6. Both the learned counsel submit that the issue in this Writ Petition is squarely covered by the order dated 16.03.206 in W.P.No.27253 of 2025, which was allowed holding as under:

"In the result, the writ petition is allowed and the impugned demand notice issued in Lr.No.SE/OP/MCL/SAO/AAO(HT)/JAO(HT)/d.No.1328, dated 26.07.2025 issued to the petitioner claiming arrears of Rs.2,64,364/- pertaining to the period 2008-09 in respect of the petitioner's unit is set aside and consequently, the respondents are directed not to disconnect the power supply to the unit of the petitioner pursuant to the said demand notice."

3. In the circumstances, following the above order and for the reasons mentioned therein, this Writ Petition is also allowed setting aside the demand notice dated NIL, affixed on the petitioner's premises on 17.12.2021 and consequently, the respondents are directed not to disconnect the power supply to the unit of the petitioner pursuant to the said demand notice. shall be no order as to costs.

Miscellaneous petitions, if any pending, shall stand closed.

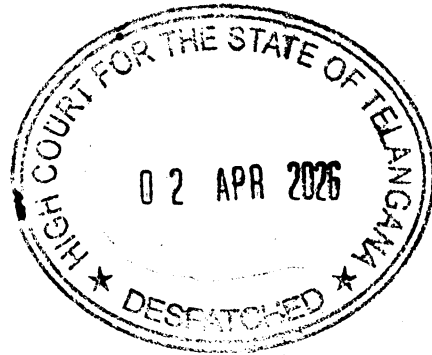
