Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to suspend the operation of impugned Order dated 24/04/2024, passed by the Central Administrative Tribunal i.e., the Respondent No.1 in OA/021/1025/2011, as being illegal, unjust, contrary to law, pending disposal of WP.No.28692 of 2024, on the file of the High Court.

THE COURT MADE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

Notice before admission.

Learned counsel for the petitioner/s is also permitted to take out personal notice to the respondent/s by registered post with acknowledgment due and file proof of service.

Vide the impugned order, dated 24.04.2024, the Central Administrative Tribunal, Hyderabad Bench, Hyderabad, has set aside the dismissal order, dated 14.12.2009, and directed the petitioners to reinstate respondent No.3 notionally, on the ground that the conviction order passed against respondent No.3 by the competent criminal Court, which was confirmed in an appeal, was set aside by this Court *vide* judgment, dated 12.04.2022, rendered in Crl.R.C.No.674 of 2014.

In view of the same, since the matter requires a detailed examination for proper and effective adjudication, the order, dated 24.04.2024, passed in O.A.No.1025 of 2011 by the Central Administrative Tribunal, Hyderabad Bench, Hyderabad, is suspended, until further orders.
