Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring Proceedings of the 3rd Respondent in Roc. No.496/2023/A3, dt.26.09.2023, placing the Petitioner under suspension, though 23 months have elapsed, which is contrary to the G.O.Rt.No.2285 (GAD Services-C) Department, Dated 18.05.2012 and law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of Ajay Kumar Choudhary Vs Union of India, reported in 2015 (7) SCC 291, and in case

of State of Tamil Nadu Vs Promod Kumar, IPS reported in 2018 SCC Online SC 1979 and consequently to set aside the proceedings of the 3rd Respondent bearing Roc. No.496/2023/A3, dt.26.09.2023 and to direct the Respondents to reinstate the Petitioner into service immediately with all consequential benefits.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to suspend the impugned Order of the 3rd respondent bearing Roc. Rt.No.2285 (GAD Services-C) Department, dated-18.05.2012, pending disposal of the main writ petition.

Heard Sri M.P.Kashyap, learned counsel for the petitioner, Sri B. Sravan Kumar, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Services-I for the respondent Nos.1 to 3 and Sri Pasham Mohith, learned Standing Counsel for the respondent No.4.

2. Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is questioning the Proceedings Roc.No.496/2023/A3 dated 26.09.2023 in placing the petitioner under suspension and not reviewing his suspension in spite of lapse of more than

2½ years as per G.O.Ms.No.526 General Administration (Services.C) Department dated 19.08.2008 and G.O.Ms.No.86 General Administration (Services.C) Department dated 08.03.1994 and requested to direct the respondents to review the suspension of the petitioner.

3. On the other hand, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Services-I submits that the respondent authorities have to review the suspension of the petitioner as per G.O.Ms.No.86 General Administration (Services.C) Department dated 08.03.1994 as well as G.O.Ms.No.526 General Administration (Services.C) Department dated 19.08.2008 in due course and requested to pass appropriate orders.

4. In view of the submission made by the both sides, the Writ Petition is disposed of directing the respondents to review the suspension of the petitioner as per G.O.Ms.No.526 General Administration (Services.C) Department dated 19.08.2008 and G.O.Ms.No.86 General Administration (Services.C) Department dated 08.03.1994 and take a decision within four (4) weeks

from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and communicate the same to the petitioner. No order as to costs.

5. Miscellaneous petitions, if any pending against the petitioner, shall stand closed.
