Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to declare the action of the 3rd respondent in issuing Procs. D.O.No. 111/2008 Rc.No. 20/PR/AS/Cyb/2007 dt. 17-1-2008 in awarding the punishment of PPI for one year with effect on future increments and pension and treating the period of suspension from 27.6.2006 till he reports for duty as "Not on duty" and the consequential proceedings issued by the 2nd respondent in D.Dis.No.3716/ Appeal.1/2009 dt. 26.2.2010 in rejecting the appeal and further proceedings issued by the 1st respondent vide Memo No. 3974/Ser.II A1/2012 dt. 25.8.2014 in rejecting the revision petition of the applicant, as illegal, unjust and contrary to Rules and consequently set aside the same.

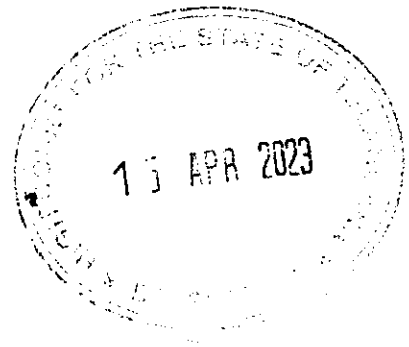
