Petition under Section 148 R/W 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the Letter dated 19-02-2026 vide Dis No.41/VII JCJ/2026, addressed by the VII Junior Civil Judge, City Civil Court, Hyderabad and forwarded by the Chief Judge, City Civil Court, Hyderabad, vide Dis No.954 of 2026, dated 20-02-2026, this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to extend the time granted on 31-10-2025 in CRP No.3679 of 2025 for a further period of six months for dispose of EP No.42 of 2011 on the file of the VII Junior Civil Judge, City Civil Court, Hyderabad.

This Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Letter dated 19-02-2026 vide Dis No.41/VII JCJ/2026, addressed by the VII Junior Civil Judge, City Civil Court, Hyderabad

The Court made the following: ORDER

The matter is taken-up for hearing on I.A.No.1 of 2026 filed by the Presiding Officer seized of E.P.No.42 of 2011. The Presiding Officer has narrated the list of dates and the proceedings drawn in between and of now also in between around nine claim petitions were separately filed. All of which have been either returned or rejected and the Executing Court is making all efforts in ensuring that the E.P. proceedings reached to its finality. Therefore, prays for six months more time. Though, the request made by the trial Court was one dated 20.02.2026 which shows



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that of now almost two months have already consumed. Further, time earlier granted was 90 days in the earlier CRP.No.3679 of 2025. Therefore extension cannot be of beyond original time that was granted.

However, considering the complications and checked history, reluctantly, though this Court granted further extension of 90 days to the Executing Court, within which, the Court should make all efforts in ensuring that EF No.42 of 2011 stands decided.

Accordingly, I.A.No.1 of 2026 stands disposed of.
