Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ declaring the action of the respondent No.2 in addressing a letter for freezing the account of the petitioner i.e. A/c. No. 025811010000014 of petitioner proprietary concern, which is with the respondent No. 3 Bank, informing the same through letter, dated 13-08-2026 intimating the freezing of the same and not permitting the petitioner to operate it even though the petitioner had not committed any offence, without issuing any notice to the petitioner and without calling any explanation from the petitioner and without following the procedure contemplated under provisions of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, is nothing but arbitrary, illegal null and void and violative of principles of natural justice and also violative of Articles 14, 19 and 21 of Constitution of India. Consequently direct the respondents No. 2 and 3 to forthwith de freeze the petitioners Bank Accounts i.e., A/c. No. 025811010000014 of petitioner proprietary concern, thereby not to prevent in any manner in operating the said account

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents No. 2 and 3 to permit the petitioner to operate the Bank Account i.e., A/c. No. 025811010000014, Pending disposal of WP No 27883 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri K Venumadhav Advocate for the Petitioners and AGP for Home for the respondents, the Court made the following.

ORDER:

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home, appearing for the respondents, seeks timer to get instructions as to the steps taken before debit freezing of the petitioner's account.

List this matter on 01.09.2026 in Adjourned Motion List. The learned counsel for the petitioner is also advised to implead the Civil Supplies Department as party respondent in the writ petition.

In the meantime, both parties are directed to maintain status-quo with regard to the balance amount in the petitioner's account.
