WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through her Advocate SRI P V KRISHNAIAH presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction, more particularly one in the nature of a writ of Mandamus under Article 226 of the Constitution of India declaring the actions of the 5th and 2nd respondents in not disposing of the representations dated 9/10/2024, 10/10/2024 and 17/10/2024 made by the petitioner to them respectively, as arbitrary, illegal, discriminatory, malafide, unconstitutional and violating Articles 14, 16 and 21 of the Constitution of India and also the actions of the 1st respondent in taking steps to consider the case of the party respondent (9th respondent) for appointment to the post of Secondary Grade Teacher (Telugu) under EWS quota based on the certificate dated 24/04/2023 issued by the 3rd respondent-Tahsildar, without disposing of the objections raised by the petitioner before the 2nd and 5th respondents as highly arbitrary, illegal, discriminatory, malafide, nothing but doing undue favour to the party respondent (9th respondent) apart from violating the

fundamental rights of the petitioner under Article 14, 16 and 21 of the Constitution of India and issue consequential directions restraining the 1st respondent from considering the case of the party respondent (9th respondent) for appointment to the post of Secondary Grade Teacher under EWS quota till the disposal of the representations dated 9/10/2024, 10/10/2024 made by the petitioner to the 5th respondent and 17/10/2024 made by the petitioner to the 2nd respondent respectively and consider the case of the petitioner under EWS quota in pursuance of the outcome of disposal of the representations made by the petitioner and further direct the respondents 6, 7 and 8 to conduct a detailed enquiry with regard not only to issuing the EWS certificate by the third respondent-Tahsildar but also on the different reports submitted by the 3rd respondent on 15/10/2024 to the 1st respondent and take appropriate action against all who involved in committing illegal actions and activities, in the interest of justice, and see that the rights provided to seek employment under EWS quota shall not be misused by anybody in any manner;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri P V KRISHNAIAH, Advocate for the Petitioner and GP for Services-I who took notice on behalf of the Respondent Nos.1 to 8, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.9 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 05-12-2024 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the 2nd and 5th respondents to consider and dispose of the representations dated 9/10/2024, 10/10/2024 made by the petitioner to the 5th respondent and 17/10/2024 made by the petitioner to the 2nd respondent respectively and consider the case of the petitioner for appointment to the post of Secondary Grade Teacher (Telugu) under EWS quota in pursuance of the Notification No.24/RC-1/TRT/DSC/ 2024 dated 29/02/2024 issued by the 2nd respondent and till such time not to appoint party respondent (9th respondent) as Secondary Grade Teacher (T) against the post reserved for EWS candidates, pending disposal of WP No. 30088 of 2024, on the file of the High Court.

Selection of respondent No.9 pursuant to Notification No.24/RC-1/TRT/DSC/2024, dated 29.02.2024, shall be subject to result of the writ petition.
