No. 55, dated 12.05.2025, consequently set aside the Letter issued by the 2nd respondent vide CCS.Ref.No.PP1(1)/3379/2025, dated 01.07.2026, Letter issued by the 6th respondent vide File No. D/97/2025, dated 07.07.2026 and the Letter issued by the 5th respondent vide File No. B/445/2026, dated 14.07.2026.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of SRI K. RAJESWARA RAO Advocate for the Petitioner, directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
