Petition under Section 430 (1 & 2) BNSS, Act, (Old Sec 389 (1) of Cr PC, praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to suspend the execution of sentence passed against the Petitioners/Accused Nos. 3, 7 to 10 in Sessions Case No. 350 of 2021 on the file of the Principal Sessions Judge, at Asifabad, dated 16/10/2024, pending disposal of CRLA No. 961 of 2024, on the file of the High Court.

Mrs. SHALINI SAXENA, Asst. PUBLIC PROSECUTOR, for the Respondent, the Court made the following;

ORDER

Heard Mr. B. Jitender Reddy, learned counsel representing Mrs. C. Vasundhara Reddy, learned counsel for the appellants, and Mrs. Shalini Saxena, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor, for the respondent-State.

To-day, when the matter is taken up for hearing on an out of turn mention made by the learned counsel for the appellants, it has been brought to the notice of the Court that the appellant No.3 / Accused No.8 (Mr. Ajmera Naveen Kumar) has participated in the recruitment process for which there is an entrance examination fixed on 23.11.2024 from 09.00 A.M. to 10:20 A.M. In this regard, learned counsel for the appellants has filed a Memo vide CrI.A.USR.No.113242 of 2024 appending copies of Hall Tickets pertaining to the said entrance examination.

Vasundhara Reddy, learned counsel for the appellants, further prayed the Court to permit the appellant No.5 / Accused No.10 (Mr. Ajmera Santhosh), to appear in B.Com (Computer Applications) Degree 5th Semester examinations, which are scheduled to be commenced from 21.11.2024 till 03.12.2024.

In view of above, the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for the respondent-State is directed to verify the contents of the said Memo and if it is found true, the appellant No.5 / Accused No.10 may be permitted to take up the above mentioned degree exams by making all necessary arrangements.
