Rama Chandra Reddy, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent-State. <u>I.A.No.4 of 2025</u> The petitioner/accused No.7 (A7) seeks interim bail. The present I.A. has been filed by the mother of the accused person. After hearing learned counsel appearing for the petitioner/A7 and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor and considering the reasons stated in the affidavit, we are of the view that the petitioner/A7 may be granted interim bail from tomorrow i.e., 30.07.2025 till 15.09.2025. I.A.No.4 of 2025 is accordingly allowed by granting interim bail to the petitioner/A7 from 30.07.2025 to 15.09.2025 subject to furnishing a bond of Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand only) with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Jail Superintendent, Central Prison, Cherlapalli, Medchal-Malkajgiri District. The petitioner/A7 shall report to the concerned Station House Officer on every alternate day till	<i>Transferred to IO folder before corrections</i>

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		15.09.2025 and the petitioner/A7 shall also make himself available as and when he is required. The petitioner/A7 shall surrender before the Jail Superintendent, Central Prison, Cherlapalli, Medchal-Malkajgiri District by 5:00 P.M. on 15.09.2025. Since the learned Additional Public Prosecutor has raised an apprehension that the petitioner/A7 may be at risk from the relatives of the deceased, we make it clear that the petitioner/A7 shall not make any effort of contacting the family members of the deceased person. <u>Crl.A.No.961 of 2024</u> List the Appeal on 30.11.2025.
