		to seat in Fernandez Hospital i.e., respondent No.4 Hospital for the post of speciality of DNBSS-Neonatology. However, it appears that the petitioner having tried his luck for a better institute in the second round of counselling, his name from the first allotted institute, i.e., respondent No.4 hospital seems to have been removed. Whereas, in the results that were published after the second round of counselling, the result showed that there has been no upgradation done in so far as the petitioner's case is concerned. If that be so, petitioner's admission to the Fernandez Hospital/ respondent No.4, for the DNBSS Neonatology Course ought to have been protected and it could not have removed from the round-II seat matrix, vide notice dated 04.06.2026. Given the aforesaid factual matrix of the case, with prima facie strong materials has made out to show that the petitioner having allocated to the respondent No.4 hospital and taking admission for the said post, the removal of the petitioner name from the said hospital seems to be prima facie not properly justified.	
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		In view of the same, there shall be interim direction that the seat allocated to the petitioner under the respondent No.4 hospital should be protected in his favour and he may be permitted to pursue his said course with the respondent No.4/hospital as allotted till the next date of hearing.
