WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through her Advocate SRI P GIRI KRISHNA presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the Respondents No.2 and 3 in withholding the Petitioners original educational certificates, namely, SSC Mark sheet, Intermediate Mark sheets, Transfer Certificate and Bonafide Certificate, pursuant to the proceedings in Lr.No.7412/KNRUHS/AC4/Disc/2026 dt.15.07.2026, and in demanding payment of Rs.20,00,000/- under Rule 2(d) of G.O.Ms.No.127 dt.22.09.2022 as a condition for release of the said certificates, as illegal, arbitrary, without jurisdiction, contrary to the very terms of Rule 2(d) of G.O.Ms.No.127 dt.22.09.2022, violative of the principles of natural justice and violative of Articles 14 and 21 of the Constitution of India, and set aside the letter dt.15.07.2026 and consequently, direct the Respondents No.2 and 3 to return to the Petitioner all original educational certificates, namely, SSC Mark sheet, Intermediate Mark sheets, Transfer Certificate and Bonafide Certificate, submitted by the Petitioner at the time of admission, without insisting on payment of the said sum of Rs.20,00,000/- or any part thereof, and further direct the Respondent No.3 to refund the sum of Rs.1,50,000/- collected from the Petitioner towards the second-year BDS course fee, since the Petitioner could not prosecute the said second year on account of her medical condition.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. P GIRI KRISHNA Advocate for the Petitioner, Government Pleader for Medical, Health and Family Welfare for respondent No.1 and Sri T.Sarath, Standing Counsel for Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences for respondent No.2, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.3 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 08.09.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

Sri T.Sarath, learned Standing Counsel for Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences takes notice on behalf of the respondent No.2.

In view of the above waiver, the Registry is directed not to take out notice to respondent Nos.1 and 2.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.3 through speed post with acknowledgment due and file proof of service in the Registry by the next date of hearing.
