Learned counsel for the appellant/defendant No.1, on instructions, would submit that respondent Nos.2 to 8/defendant Nos.2 to 8 are tenants of the suit schedule properties and respondent No.1/plaintiff did not seek any relief against them. Therefore, she seeks time to file a memo stating that respondent Nos.2 to 8 are not necessary parties to the present appeal. List on 27.10.2026. In the meanwhile, Registry shall call for the original record in O.S.No.211 of 2014 from the learned Principal District Judge, Warangal, prepare paper book and put up the same in the bundle. <u>I.A.No.1 of 2026</u> <i>Vide</i> the impugned Judgment and Decree, dated 10.06.2026, in O.S.No.211 of 2014, learned trial Court passed a Preliminary Decree holding that both plaintiff/respondent No.1 and defendant No.1/appellant are entitled for equal share in item No.1 of schedule A property, as per Section 8 of the Hindu Succession Act,	

	1956. No relief was granted in respect of item No.2 and claim of the plaintiff/respondent No.1 was dismissed in respect of item No.2 of schedule A property. Several grounds and contentions raised by the parties can be considered at the time of hearing of the appeal finally. There shall be stay of passing of final decree pursuant to Judgment and Decree, dated 10.06.2026, in O.S.No.211 of 2014 passed by the learned Principal District Judge, Warangal.
