Petition under Section 430 R/w Sec 483 of BNSS., praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to extend the period of interim bail granted on 24/04/2025 in IA.No.01 of 2025, pending disposal of Criminal Appeal No. 971 of 2024, for a period of five to six months, as a temporary arrangement to take care of his wife and daughter, pending disposal of CRLA No. 971 of 2024, on the file of the High Court.

Petition under Section 430 R/w Section 483 of BNSS, praying that in the circumstances stated in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to enlarge the petitioner on bail pending disposal of Criminal Appeal No.971 of 2024 for a period of five to six months as a temporary arrangement to take care of his wife;

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition filed in support thereof and the order of the High Court dated 24.04.2025 made in I.A.No.1 of 2025 and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Ennamsetty Akhil, Advocate Representing M/s Jurislit Law LLP, Advocate for the petitioner and Sri Rama Chandra Reddy, Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent, the Court made the following

ORDER:

Considering the submissions made on behalf of the petitioner/appellant (A-15) for the extension of interim bail and the Report of the Sub-Inspector of Police,

Rebenna Police Station, Kumuram Bheem Asifabad District, dated 11.07.2025, we are of the view that the interim bail of the petitioner may be extended till 04.08.2025.

I.A.No.2 of 2025 is accordingly allowed and disposed of by extending the interim bail of the petitioner till 04.08.2025.

The petitioner shall report to the concerned Station House Officer every alternate day till 04.08.2025 and shall also make himself available as and when required.

The petitioner shall surrender before the Superintendent, Central Prison, Cherlapalli, Medchal-Malkajgiri District by 05:00 PM on 04.08.2025.

We make it clear that, henceforth, no application for extension of interim bail shall be entertained within four days prior to the date on which the convict/appellant is due to surrender before the concerned prison.
