Petition under Section 430 R/W Section 483 of BNSS, 2023, praying that in the
circumstances stated in the petition, the High Court may be pleased to release the
Petitioner on interim bail for a period of three months, as a temporary arrangement,
to take care of his daughter in CrI.A.No.971 of 2024 on the file of this Hon'ble Court.

The Court made the following

ORDER:

**This application is filed by petitioner/A16 to grant interim bail for
a period of three months contending that his daughter is suffering with
neurological issue and she is now staying with her distant relative.
There is no one to take care of her. It is also contended by the**

petitioner/A16 that his wife, brother, brother's wife and others are in jail.

In proof of the same, he has filed certificate, dated 06.07.2025 issued by Suresh Neuro and Multi Specialty Hospital, Mancherial. He has also filed photographs, patient information etc.,

In the light of the same, we have directed the learned Additional Public Prosecutor to get instructions on the same.

Sri Dodla Arun Kumar, learned Additional Public Prosecutor produced written instructions of Sub-Inspector of Police, wherein he has stated that on enquiry, he came to know that daughter of petitioner/appellant is suffering from neurological issue and she is taking treatment in Sanjana children's Hospital, Mancherial. The welfare of the child is being looked after her mother and her uncle. It is further stated that both the complainant and accused are from the same village and if interim bail is granted to the petitioner, there might be law and order problem in the village.

Sri Ennamsetty Akhil, learned counsel for the petitioner/A16 on instructions would submit that this Court granted interim bail to four accused. They were released on bail. They stayed in the said village and there are no issues.

In the light of the same, we are inclined to grant interim bail to the petitioner herein for a period to two months from 21.08.2025.

Accordingly, this petition is ordered directing the Superintendant, Central Prison, Cherlapalli to release the petitioner-life convict on 21.08.2025 at 11.00 A.M.

During interim bail, the petitioner/A16 shall comply with the following conditions:

i) He shall report before the Rebenna Police Station, Kumrambheem Asifabad District weekly once i.e., every Sunday between 10.00 A.M. and 5.00 P.M.

ii) He shall not involve in any criminal activities.

iii) Liberty is granted to the Public Prosecutor to file application seeking cancellation of bail in the event of involvement of the petitioner in any criminal acts.

iv) On completion of the aforesaid two months period, the petitioner shall surrender before the Superintendent, Central Prison, Cherlapalli on 21.10.2025 by 11.00 A.M.
