O R D E R

1. This Criminal Petition is filed under Sections 480 and 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (BNSS) praying this Court to enlarge the petitioner – A11 on bail in connection with Crime No.197 of 2026 of Allapur Police Station, Cyberabad. The offences alleged against the petitioner – A11 are punishable under Sections 8 (c) read with 20 (b) (ii) (c), 27 (b), 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short, NDPS Act').

2. Heard Sri Alluri Divakar Reddy, learned counsel for petitioner – A11 and Sri D. Arun Kumar, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, appearing for respondent – State.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner – A11 is in judicial custody since 26.04.2026, he is falsely implicated in the case and nothing to do with the alleged offences. Police have completed entire investigation, question of tampering evidence does not arise, he is ready to cooperate with the Investigating Agency and also ready to abide by the terms and conditions which are imposed by the Court. A7, A9 and A10 were enlarged by this Court on 31.08.2026 in CrI.P.Nos.12863, 13149 and 13153 of 2026 holding that inventory is completed on 22.08.2026 and prayed to enlarge the petitioner – A11 on bail.

4. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor submits that the role played by the petitioner – A11 is clearly depicted in the remand case diary.

5. Petitioner – A11 has filed CrI.P.No.10334 of 2026 for grant of bail, the same came to be dismissed on 21.07.2026 holding that petitioner – A11 was present in the same premises along with other accused and the contraband was seized from them is commercial quantity of 2.135 Kgs of Weed oil.

6. The changed circumstances in the investigation is that inventory is completed on 22.08.2026. Furthermore, A7, A9 and A10 were enlarged on bail on 31.08.2026.

7. Since major portion of investigation is completed, detaining the petitioner – A11 further in judicial custody will not serve the purpose. Accordingly, this Court is of the view that the petitioner – A11 is entitled for grant of bail, subject to the following conditions:

- i. The petitioner – A11 shall execute a personal bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only), with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of concerned Court.
- ii. The petitioner –A11 shall appear before the concerned SHO between 11:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., on every Sunday for a period of eight (8) weeks or till filing of charge sheet whichever is earlier, for the purpose of investigation and thereafter, as and when required.
- iii. The petitioner – A.11 shall abide by the conditions stipulated in Section 437(3) of Cr.P.C. (presently, Section 480(3) of the BNSS).

- iv. The petitioner - A.11 shall not directly or indirectly influence, threaten, or induce any of the prosecution witnesses.
- v. In the event of violation of any of the above conditions, the prosecution is at liberty to file an application for cancellation of bail.

8. Accordingly, this Criminal Petition is allowed.

Miscellaneous applications, if any pending, shall stand closed.
