The Court made the following Order :

**THE HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE B. VIJAYSEN REDDY****CONTEMPT CASE No.2450 OF 2024****ORDER: (ORAL)**

Mr. B. Mayur Reddy, learned Senior Counsel, appearing for Mr. K.V. Raman, learned counsel for the respondent - contemnor, furnished written instructions and stated that in compliance of the order passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in W.P. (Civil) No.1325 of 2020 dated 20.03.2023 and order of this Court in W.P. No.5394 of 2024, the High Court for the State of Telangana has engaged Technical Agency and their development team is coordinating with the National Informatics Centre (NIC) to develop a comprehensive and centralized Right to Information (RTI) portal for all the Courts of District Judiciary in the State of Telangana.

2. Learned Senior Counsel also referred to the several services which are being provided under RTI portal of the District Judiciary and necessary steps are being taken for seeding the District Judiciary portal with High Court of Telangana RTI website and prayed to close the contempt case.

3. However, petitioner - Party-in-Person prayed that the contempt case may not be closed.

4. Noting that there is substantial compliance of the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, the contempt case is closed. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner - Party-In-Person to approach this Court after reasonable time, if the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court is not complied with in letter and spirit. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel thereto, miscellaneous applications, if any, pending in this contempt case stand closed.

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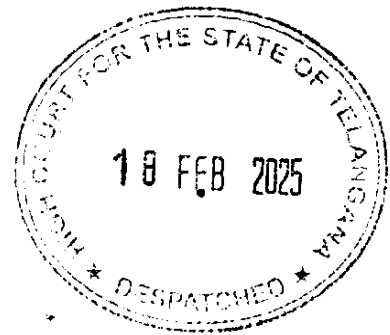
