Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, order or direction, preferably in the nature of Writ of Mandamus by declaring the Proceedings No.40/SB/L&O/CYB/2026 dated 17.7.2026 issued by the respondent no.10 is without jurisdiction, arbitrary, and the consequent action on the part of the HYDRAA and revenue authorities in illegally fencing all that part and parcel of all that

agricultural land bearing Old Survey No.62, New Survey No.41/8 admeasuring Ac.1.00 Gts out of Ac.1.25 Gts situated at Bahadurguda Village, Shamshabad Mandal, Ranga Reddy District, and also the inaction on the part of the Commissioner, HYDRABAD in not considering the representation of the petitioner dated 28.08.2026, as illegal arbitrary, mala fide illegal, without the power and without jurisdiction, in violation of Constitutional guarantees contained under Article 300-A of the Constitution of India, with a further direction to remove the fencing laid around all that agricultural land bearing Old Survey No.62, New Survey No.41/8 admeasuring Ac.1.00 Gts out of Ac.1.25 Gts situated at Bahadurguda Village, Shamshabad Mandal, Ranga Reddy District;

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents not to change the nature of the property thereby restraining them from interfering with the right of access to the petitioner property in Old Survey No 62, New Survey No.41/8 admeasuring Ac.1.00 Gts out of Ac.1.25 Gts situated at Bahadurguda Village, Shamshabad Mandal, Ranga Reddy District, pending disposal of WP No.29803 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the grounds filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri R.A. Achuthanand, Advocate for the Petitioner, Government Pleader for Mcpl Admn and Urban Dev for the Respondent No.1, Government Pleader for Revenue for the Respondent Nos.5 to 8 and Government Pleader for Home for the Respondent Nos.9 to 10, the Court made the following.

ORDER:

In similar circumstances, the common order dated 21.07.2026 was passed by this Court in W.P. Nos.23850 and 23745 of 2026 and requested similar order may be passed in this writ petition.

Hence, *status quo* obtaining as on today shall be maintained in respect of the land admeasuring Ac.1-00 guntas in Survey No.41/8 (Old Survey No.62), situated at Bahadurguda Village, Shamshabad Mandal, Ranga Reddy District, till the next date of hearing.

Respondents No.4, 7 and 8 are directed not to interfere with the ingress and aggress of the petitioner in respect of the subject property without following due process of law.
