Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Mandamus, declaring the action of the Respondent Authorities more particularly

Respondent No.5 in passing the Section 3G(1) Award proceedings vide File No. F1/2218/2020 dated 10.03.2023, pursuant to the Declaration under Section 3D(1) dated 13.01.2022 and the Notification under Section 3A(1) dated 10.02.2021, with respect to the lands of the Petitioners situated in Maganoor Village and Mandal, Narayanpet District, for the public purpose of four-laning of the Deosugur-Jadcherla Section of NH-167 (Km.181.200 to Km.283.000), as illegal, arbitrary, without jurisdiction, in violation of the mandatory requirements the National Highways Act, 1956 and the principles of natural justice, apart from being violation of Articles 14, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and consequently set aside the Section 3G(1) Award proceedings vide File No. F1/2218/2020 dated 10.03.2023, the Declaration under Section 3D(1) dated 13.01.2022 and the Notification under Section 3A(1) dated 10.02.2021, with respect to the lands of the Petitioners situated in Maganoor Village.

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Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondents to restrain from dispossessing or taking any coercive action against the Petitioners lands, pending disposal of WP No 29502 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the grounds filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of S Goutham Advocate for the Petitioners, N Bhujanga Rao Deputy Solicitor General Of India for the Respondent Nos.1, Mr. Medishetty Ramu, Advocate for respondent Nos. 2 & 7 and Assistant Government Pleader for Land Acquisition for respondent Nos. 3 to 6, the Court made the following.

ORDER:

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Land Acquisition seeks time to get instructions from the respondent Nos.3 to 6.

Post after two (2) weeks in the adjourned motion list.

List on 23.09.2026.

Till then, the respondents are directed not to dispossess the petitioners from the suit schedule property and not to take any coercive steps against the petitioners.
