Sri E.Ganesh, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor, for State. <u>I.A.No.1 of 2026</u> Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the learned Sessions Court has not properly appreciated the evidence of the prosecution witnesses in proper perspective and convicted the petitioner-accused for the offence he is charged with. Petitioner-accused has strong case in succeeding the appeal. The grounds raised in the appeal may be read as part and parcel of the petition. Petitioner-accused is tried for the offence under Section 8 (c) read with 22 (b) (ii) (B) of the NDPS Act, 1985 in NDSC No.5 of 2019. After full-fledged trial, the learned XIII Additional District and Sessions Judge, Cyberabad, Ranga Reddy District, L.B.Nagar has convicted the petitioner-accused <i>vide</i> judgment dated 31.08.2026 and sentenced him to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of five years and shall pay fine of Rs.25,000/-. In default of payment of fine, he shall undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of six months. Petitioner-accused is in jail since 31.08.2026. Since the petitioner-accused has strong case in succeeding the appeal, the Judgment passed by the	

		learned learned XIII Additional District and Sessions Judge, Cyberabad, Ranga Reddy District, L.B.Nagar, in NDSC No.5 of 2019 dated 31.08.2026, is suspended and bail is granted on executing a personal bond for Rs.25,000/- with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the trial Court. <u>Crl.A.No.1034 of 2026</u> Admit.
