1.	09.09.2026	<u>JS,J</u> <u>I.A.No.1 of 2026</u> This application is filed seeking to direct respondent No.4-college to collect the fee from the petitioner as follows: <i>“(i) as a candidate belonging to Category-B, @ 70% of the amount payable as per G.O.Ms.No.107, dated 28.07.2023 and G.O.Ms.No.131, dated 18.08.2023 issued by respondent No.1;</i> <i>(ii) the petitioner, falling within the ambit of Category-B, shall at the time of payment furnish a personal bond undertaking to pay the remaining amount on disposal of the present writ petition, in case the same is required to be paid; and</i> <i>(iii) pass such other orders.”</i> Heard Mr. Ekant Hiranandani, learned counsel for the petitioner, Mr. R.Nagarjun Reddy, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Medical, Health and Family Welfare Department appearing for respondent No.1, Mr. T.Sharat, learned Standing Counsel for KNRUHS appearing for respondent No.2 and Mr. G.Chandrashekar Reddy, learned Standing Counsel for TAFRC appearing for respondent No.3. Perused the record. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the issue raised in the present writ petition is squarely covered by the interim order, dated 17.12.2025 passed by the Hon’ble Division Bench of this Court in	

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		W.A.Nos.341, 350, 351, 352, 515, 516, 518, 771, 1045, 1047, 1048 and 1049 of 2025, W.P.Nos.6799 and 7455 of 2020, 12347 of 2022, 3896 of 2023, 13895, 15111, 21279, 22859, 24958, 26207, 28690 and 33424 of 2025. He further submits that on the ground of parity, the petitioner is also entitled to the same benefit and prayed this Court to extend the similar interim direction to the petitioner herein. Learned counsel appearing for the respondents reported no objection. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, on the ground of parity, there shall be interim direction as prayed for. <u>W.P.No.29857 of 2026</u> Notice before admission.
