WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through its Advocate SRI MIR MASOOD KHAN presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue writ, order or direction, one more particularly in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS TO COMMAND and declare the acts actions of respondent No. 2 in receiving representation dated 01-01-2026 from respondent No. 4 forwarding the same to respondent No. 3 thereby issuing Letter No. 127/ Societies /2026 dated 07-07-2026 (Ex. P1) calming oral instructions from respondent No. 3 that the petitioner society has been made inactive in department records without notice or opportunity of being heard is arbitrary, ultravires, capricious, illegal, without Jurisdiction, NONEST, no power jurisdiction to receive, write or communicate with unauthorized persons against which is against the mandate of Andhra Pradesh Society Registration Act, 2001 and byelaws of petitioners society consequently set aside / quash the Letter No. 127/ Societies /2026 dated 07- 07-2026 (Ex. P1) issued by respondent No. 2.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of SRI MIR MASOOD KHAN Advocate for the Petitioner and GP FOR STAMPS AND REGISTRATION for the Respondents No. 1 to 3 directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.4 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

You viz:

are directed to show cause on or before **04.11.2026** to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to suspend Letter No. 127/ Societies /2026 dated 07-07-2026 (Ex. P1) issued by respondent No. 2 in the interest of justice., pending disposal of WP No 29898 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following

ORDER:

Notice before Admission.

Learned Government Pleader for Stamps and Registration takes notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3, waives further notice and seeks time to file a counter affidavit.

Registry is directed not to take out further notices to respondent Nos.1 to 3, in view of the above waiver.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.4 through Speed Post with Acknowledgment Due, and to file proof of service in the Registry by the next date of hearing.

It is stated that the petitioner is a society registered under the provisions of the Andhra Pradesh Societies Registration Act, 2001 and is actively promoting boxing in the State of Telangana. The case of the petitioner is that respondent No.2, without issuing any notice or affording an opportunity of hearing, entertained a representation from respondent No.4, who is not a member of the society, and issued the impugned Letter No.127/Societies/2026 dated 07.07.2026 stating that the society was made inactive in the departmental records. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondent No.2 has no power or jurisdiction to entertain such communication from a stranger or interfere with the affairs of the society in the manner done.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that, in similar circumstances, this Court has passed an interim order in W.P.No.10240 of 2024 dated 19.04.2024 and requests this Court to grant similar interim protection in the present writ petition also.

The same is not disputed by the learned Government Pleader for respondent Nos.1 to 3.

In view of the above and following the interim order passed in W.P.No.10240 of 2024 dated 19.04.2024, there shall be interim suspension of the impugned letter No.127/societies/2026 dated 07.07.2026 issued by respondent No.2.

Post on 04.11.2026, for filing counter-affidavit.
