Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus to declare the action of Respondent No. 8 in not providing Police Protection to the Petitioner and his family members upon the Petitioner's call on dial 100 and approaching physically to submit complaint of Petitioner to official Mobile Number of the Respondent No. 8 from Petitioner's Mobile Numbers 9550998664, 7013549650 on 10.11.2024 at about 11 A M and the Respondent No. 5 directed Respondent No. 5 to provide Police protection to petitioner and her family members in view of serious land disputes between Petitioner and unofficial Respondents to conduct agricultural operations in agricultural land to an extent of Ac. 17.05 Gts in Sy No: 392, 392/1, 316, 315/3, 313/A, 312/E, 76.78, 80 91 situated at

Madugula Village and Mandal, in spite of having clear orders of this Hon'ble Court in WP No. 4583 of 2021 dated 13.02.2024 and also directed the Respondent Authorities to conduct de novo enquiry over land disputes between Petitioner and unofficial Respondents is illegal, arbitrary, in violation of principals of natural justice and against the articles 14 19 g b 21 and 300 A constitution of India and consequently direct the Respondent No 8 to provide Police protection to the Petitioner and her family members to conduct agricultural operations/collection of Cotton from the land in Sy No to an extent of Ac Gts situated at Madugula Village and Mandal R R District:

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondent No 8 to provide Police protection to the Petitioner and his family members to conduct of agricultural operations / collection of Cotton from the agricultural land to an extent of Ac. 17.05 Gts in Sy No. 392, 392/1, 316, 315/3, 313/A, 312/E, 76, 78, 80 91 situated at Madugula Village and Mandal, Pending disposal of WP 32083 of 2024, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. RAMA KRISHNA KULKARNI Advocate for the Petitioner, GP FOR HOME for the Respondent Nos.1,8,12,13, GP FOR WOMENS AND CHILD WELFARE for respondent Nos.2 & 4, GP FOR REVENUE for respondent Nos.3,5,6,7, the Court made the following.

ORDER:

In compliance of the order dated 02.01.2025 passed by this Court, respondent No.7 - the Tahsildar, Madgul Mandal, has furnished instructions to the learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue stating that he has conducted enquiry as to who raised the cotton crop in the land admeasuring Acs.17-05 guntas in Survey nos.392, 392/1, 316, 315/3, 313/A, 312/E, 76, 80 and 91 situated at Madgul Village and Mandal, Ranga Reddy District.

During his physical inspection he found that Mrs. Sudini Sunitha, petitioner herein, is having the possession of land admeasuring Ac.0-20 guntas in Survey No.76, Ac.0-26 guntas in Survey No.78, Acs.2-33 guntas in Survey No.80, Acs.3-26 guntas in Survey No.91, total admeasuring Acs.7-25 guntas, situated at Madgul Village and Mandal, Ranga Reddy District, and she has raised the cotton crop in the said land. The remaining extent of land is in possession of Mr. Jayachandra Reddy who also raised cotton crop.

As per the enquiry of respondent No.7, petitioner raised cotton crop only to the extent of Acs.7-25 guntas, hence, respondent No.8 - the Station House Officer, Madgul Police Station, is directed to provide Police protection to the petitioner only to the extent of land admeasuring Ac.0-20 guntas in Survey No.76, Ac.0-26 guntas in Survey No.78,

Acs.2-33 guntas in Survey No.80, Acs.3-26 guntas in Survey No.91, total admeasuring Acs.7-25 guntas, situated at Madgul Village and Mandal, Ranga Reddy District, for harvesting cotton crop.
