Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to vacate the interim stay vide I.A No. 2 of 2025 order dated 28.10.2025 in MACMA No.1505 of 2025 and also permit the Petitioner to withdraw the deposited amount in the interest of justice, pending disposal of MACMA No. 1505 of 2025, on the file of the High Court.

I.A No. 2 of 2025:

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings in pursuance of the award and the decree dated 6/5/2025 passed in M.V.O.P. No. 706 of 2022 on the file of the Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal -cum- Chief Judge, City Civil Court, Hyderabad, pending disposal of MACMA No. 1505 of 2025, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and the order of the High Court dated 28.10.2025 made in I.A No. 2 of 2025 and upon hearing the arguments of Sri T MAHENDER RAO Advocate for the Respondent No. 1 in I.A No. 3 of 2025 and Sri M LINGAM Advocate for the Petitioner in I.A No. 3 of 2025.

The Court made the following
ORDER

This application is filed by the claimants/respondents requesting to vacate the interim stay order passed by this Court in I.A.No.2 of 2025 in MACMA No.1505 of 2025, dated 28.10.2025.

Heard both learned counsel for the parties.

Learned Counsel for the vacate stay petitioner-claimant submits that on account of death of the sole bread winner, he is unable to maintain the family and he is in dire need of money for their sustenance and therefore, he may be permitted to withdraw the amount so deposited by the appellant-Insurance Company.

Having regard to the aforesaid submissions, this Court is satisfied that at this stage, permission can be granted.

Accordingly, the vacate stay petitioner-claimant is permitted to withdraw the 50% of the decretal amount so deposited by the appellant-Insurance Company by following the procedure established by law.

This interlocutory application is allowed.
