Petition under Section 528 of BNSS praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay of all further proceedings including appearance of petitioner/ Accused in C.C. No. 475 of 2022, on the file of Principal Junior Civil Judge Cum Principal Judicial Magistrate of First Class at Jagtial, pending disposal of CRLP No. 13780 of 2025, on the file of the High Court.

The court while directing issue of notice to the Respondent herein to show cause as to why this application should not be complied with, made the following order.(The receipt of this order will be deemed to be the receipt of notice in the case).

ORDER

This application is filed by the petitioner-accused seeking to grant stay of all further proceedings including appearance of the petitioner-

accused in C.C.No.475 of 2022 on the file of Principal Junior Civil Judge cum Principal Judicial Magistrate of First Class at Jagtial registered for the offence under section 420 of IPC.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor appearing for the State-respondent.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegations in the complaint and charge sheet are purely civil in nature and petitioner had not committed any such offence as alleged in the charge sheet, but the respondent No.2 with an intention to harass the petitioner has foisted the said complaint against her.

It is submitted that the petitioner is only sister of Naluvala Narsingam, her brother died on 22.07.2003 and later on the son and wife of his brother died on 16.11.2020 and 12.05.2010, the petitioner being a class II legal heir succeeded the land admeasuring Ac.0.1650 gts in Sy.No.216/11 and Ac.1.16 gts in Sy.No.216/1/2, situated at Porandla village, Jagtial Rural Mandal, Jagtial District. On an application submitted by the petitioner, after following due procedure contemplated under Telangana Rights in Land and Pattadar pass books Act, the competent authority i.e. Tahsildar, issued succession proceedings and also mutated the name of the petitioner in the Revenue records.

It is further submitted that the respondent No.2 is no way concerned with the family of the petitioner's brother, but she is claiming that she is the wife of brother of the petitioner and had foisted the said false complaint, eventhough it is showing in her Aadhaar card that she is the wife of Naluvala Raya Ellaiah.

He further submits that that the subject matter proceedings were already set aside by the District Collector through proceedings No.D1/1224/2022, dated 06.01.2023, without issuing any notice to the petitioner, then the same was challenged by the petitioner before this Court in W.P.No.1453 of 2023 and this Court through interim orders dated 19.01.2023 suspended the said proceedings of the District

Collector and subsequently the final orders were also passed in the said writ petition, setting aside the proceedings of the District Collector, dated 06.01.2023 and directed the said authority to conduct a fresh enquiry after affording an opportunity to the petitioner as well as other interested parties, and initiation and continuation of the criminal proceedings against the petitioner are nothing but abuse of process of Court. Hence, prays to grant stay of all further proceedings.

The submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, do require detailed examination.

In the said circumstances, there shall be stay of all further proceedings including appearance in respect of petitioner-accused in C.C.No.475 of 2022 on the file of Principal Junior Civil Judge cum Principal Judicial Magistrate of First Class at Jagtial, till 24.11.2025.
