Writ appeal under Clause 15 of the Letter Patent Act, praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed herein, the High Court may be pleased to set aside the Order dt. 26-09-2025 in W.P.No.20111/2025 to the extent it upholds the promotion of the Appellant herein (Writ Petitioner No.3) and declare that the Appellant is entitled to forego his promotion under Rule 11(b) of the Telangana State and Subordinate Service Rules, 1996 and quash the impugned G.O.Rt.No.298 dt. _07-2025 insofar as it relates to the Appellant and direct the Respondents to retain and continue the appellant in the place in which he is working.

**IA NO: 2 OF 2025:**

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to suspend the operation of the impugned judgment dt. 26-09-2025 in W.P.No.20111 of 2025, to the extent it upholds the promotion of the Appellant (Writ Petitioner No.3) under G.O.Rt.No.298, Health, Medical & Family Welfare (A) Department, dt.07-07-2025, and consequently direct the Respondents to retain and continue the Appellant in his present position as Professor of Ophthalmology, Gandhi Medical College, Secunderabad, pending disposal of the WA.No.1192 of 2025, on the file of the High Court.

The Appeal coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the grounds filed in support thereof and the order of the High Court dated 29.10.2025 & 27.11.2025 made herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri SRINIVAS BOBBILI Advocate for the Petitioner, GP FOR SERVICES I Advocate for the Respondents and the Court made the following.
