Petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings including the personal appearance of petitioners/A1 and A6 in C.C.No. 858 of 2021 on the file of the Court of Judicial First Class Magistrate, at Jangaon, pending disposal of CRLP No. 10625 of 2022, on the file of the High Court.

The court while directing issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this application should not be complied with, made the following.(The receipt of this order will be deemed to be the receipt of notice in the case).

ORDER:

The case against the petitioners-Accused Nos.1 and 6 *prima facie* appear to be regarding the sale and purchase of property which is presently in the name of 2nd respondent-*de facto* complainant. Regarding the disputes, a Civil Suit was also filed which was later withdrawn by the accused No.1. Aggrieved by the said withdrawn, the *de facto* complainant-2nd respondent filed the present petition. The case appears to be predominantly civil in nature.

In view of the above discussion, there shall be stay of all further proceedings against the petitioners-accused Nos.1 and 6 in C.C.No.858 of 2021 pending on the file of Judicial First Class Magistrate, Jangaon, till 28.12.2022.

Meanwhile, issue notice to 2nd respondent- *de facto* complainant.

Learned counsel for the petitioners accused Nos.1 and 6 is also permitted to take out personal notice on to the 2nd respondent - *de facto* complainant by registered post with acknowledgment due and file proof of service in the Registry before the next date of hearing.

Needless to say on failure to serve notice on to the 2nd respondent - *de facto* complainant, there shall be no further extension of the Stay and the trial Court is directed to proceed with the matter thereafter.
