Mr. Karthik Ramana Puttamreddy, learned counsel appears for the petitioners in W.P.Nos.27847 and 31588 of 2025. Mr. Kailash Nath P.S.S., learned counsel appears for the petitioner in W.P.No.33388 of 2025. Mr. Dominic Fernandes, learned Senior Standing Counsel for Central Board of Indirect Taxes and Customs (CBIC), appears for the respondents-CGST. Since W.P.Nos.21916 and 21942 of 2025 relate to a different issue of cancellation of registration of the petitioners, they are being segregated from the present batch. W.P.No.35904 of 2025 is also segregated from the present batch. In W.P.No.8857 of 2025, counter affidavit has been filed, but prayer for adjournment is made as learned counsel for the petitioner is out of station. No reply affidavit has been filed by the petitioner.
